

Over forty workers have come forward with stories about their experiences of wage theft and other mistreatment at the site of the Viking Lakes project owned by the Wilf family development company MV Ventures. We not only believe these worker accounts regarding their mistreatment, but we support them in their fight for justice. Forty workers do not come forward with no basis to complain.

The Wilf family has benefitted from public subsidy money, perhaps more than any other family in Minnesota history. They need to be held to a higher standard. Today, we call on the Wilf family to reach agreement with Building Dignity and Respect Standards Council (“BDC”) to resolve worker claims on the Viking Lakes development and to engage with BDC, the North Central States Regional Council of Carpenters, the Laborers District Council of Minnesota and North Dakota, and Centro de Trabajadores Unidos en Lucha to ensure workers never again are subjected to the treatment they received on the Viking Lakes Project.
